The Community Artist position is a 12-month paid leadership training program for emerging community-based artists on the margins.

Who should apply: Youth impacted by marginalization and poverty with a demonstrated passion for artful community organizing and working in the following mediums: drawing, painting, sculpture, installation, textiles, movement, music, digital arts, pottery, printmaking, and/or performance. Applicants must be 18-29, living in the Greater Toronto Area.
